

GSL - State Parks Administrative authority and responsibilities:

UCA Title 63-11-17.1 Recreation authority. Manage and assist other agencies with recreation. Access, Interpretation, information services, and visitor contact.

State parks that boarder or are contained within the GSL:

- GSL Marina
- Antelope Island
- Willard Bay

State Park managed access points – GSL State Marina (non-commercial only/Recreation), Antelope Island Marina (Recreation and Commercial marina)

UCA Title 73-18, 18a, 18b, & 18c - Utah Boating Act and rules promulgated under that act - Authorizes Utah State Parks and Recreation to administer the statewide boating program on Utah's lakes, reservoirs, and rivers including safety, education, and enforcement. Includes water related public safety response and search and rescue responsibilities on the GSL.

Contracts/Agreements

1. Forestry Fire and State Lands & State Parks:
 - i. State Parks manages a 1 mile buffer around Antelope Island State Park for hunting, recreation, and public safety
 - ii. State Parks provides visitor contact and public safety/law enforcement for the Saltair/Forestry Fire and Sovereign Land's beaches adjacent to the GSL State Marina
 - iii. Control and patrol ATV access by the Brine Shrimp industry along Forestry Fire and Sovereign Land's beaches during the brine shrimp harvest
2. Interagency Preplan for search and rescue on the GSL (5 Counties, SL Airport, State and Federal Agencies)
 - i. Initial contact for any incident on GSL is made to State Parks – DPR calls the appropriate county/agency.
 - ii. Response is determined by action category.
3. Hill Air Force Base Oasis Bombing Range
 - i. State Parks provides public safety response/contact (mainly trespassers)
 - ii. Coordinate search rescue for the range.

Revenue/Budget for park operations in and around the GSL:

1/3 general fund, 1/3 park fee revenue, 1/3 OHV & boating restricted
